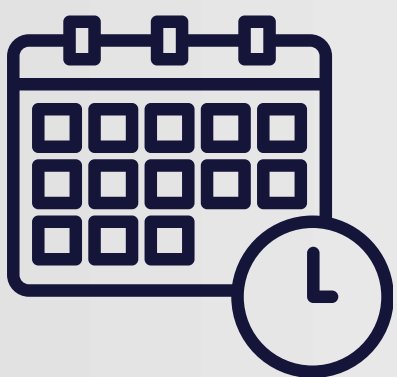

OVERVIEW

A/Prof Christopher C.K. Ho is a Specialist Prosthodontist with an international reputation in aesthetic and implant dentistry. He graduated with First Class Honours from the University of Sydney and has completed extensive postgraduate training, including a Graduate Diploma in Clinical Dentistry (Oral Implants) and a Doctorate in Clinical Dentistry in Prosthodontics from the University of Sydney, as well as a Master of Clinical Dentistry in Prosthodontics with Distinction from the University of London.

He is a Fellow of multiple prestigious international organisations, including the Pierre Fauchard Academy, the International College of Dentists, the American College of Dentists, the College of General Dentistry (UK), and the Australian and New Zealand College of Prosthodontists. He is also a Special Field Member in Prosthodontics of the Royal Australasian College of Dental Surgeons.

A/Prof Ho lectures extensively both nationally and internationally, focusing on advanced aesthetic, implant, and digital dentistry. He holds academic appointments as Clinical Associate Professor at the University of Sydney and serves as Adjunct Faculty in Prosthodontics at Tufts University School of Dental Medicine (Boston), King's College London, and the University of Puthisastra.

He is currently Head of School of Postgraduate Dentistry at the Australasian College of Dental Practitioners. In addition to his clinical and academic roles, he is an accomplished author and editor, having contributed to numerous publications and serving as editor of the Wiley textbooks Practical Procedures in Aesthetic Dentistry and Practical Procedures in Implant Dentistry.
